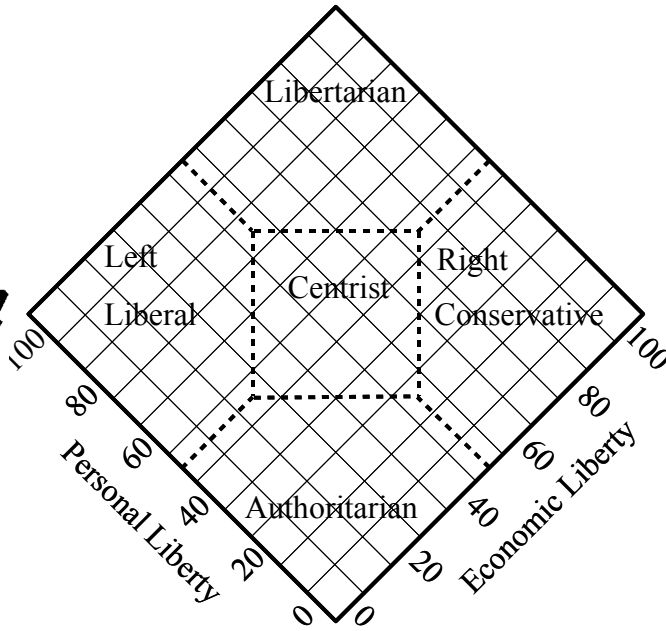


Where do you fit on the political map?
